
Quick Reference Guide: Getting Started with eCampus 9.2


eCampus Student Homepage, after September 4th, 2017

Make sure to **allow pop-ups** on eCampus. You will be unable to access some pages if you do not allow pop-ups on eCampus.

The eight (8) tiles featured on the landing page contain various sets of information related to your eCampus account. The tiles are described briefly below. For further details on a tile, please refer to the corresponding page dedicated specifically to the tile.



The Profile tile allows you to update personal information and manage


passwords.



The Manage Classes tile allows you to search for, enroll in, drop, and swap classes. Weekly schedules may also be viewed here. **Please note**: At this time, you will not be able to search for and enroll in classes while on a mobile device.



The Grades and History tile allows you to view grades and course history.




The Academics tile allows you to request transcripts and degree audits, view enrollment dates and weekly schedules, and declare a Pathway.



The Financial Aid tile allows you to view and accept/decline award or aid

letters.



The Financial account tile allows you to view your account details and

manage your SCU bills.



The Additional Resources tile allows students to sign up for the SCU Campus Alert, purchase parking permits, manage housing, and vote in student elections.



The Tasks tile allows you to view any holds you have on your account.

There are three buttons in the upper right hand corner of the page.

The Home button brings you back to the Student Homepage. **Please note:** This button will not exist for students on mobile devices. Use the hamburger menu to return Home instead.

The Notifications button shows any actions and alerts that must be addressed in a drop-down menu.

The hamburger menu shows a drop-down menu that allows you to quickly access the Manage Password page and to sign out of eCampus. **Please note:** For increased security on eCampus, you will automatically be signed out after 20 minutes of inactivity. If you are on a mobile device, Home will be another option in the drop-down menu.
